



2025 Munday Curd Scholar Application REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your interest in Pyramid Federal Credit Union's Munday Curd Scholarship program, honoring long-time volunteer and former manager of Pyramid Federal Credit Union. Please read this page carefully. You will be asked to sign your application stating that you have read and understand this information. Criteria

Any high school senior graduating in the spring of 2025, who is a Pyramid Federal Credit Union member in good standing and is going into any area of study at a university or technical college, may apply for a <u>first-year scholarship</u>. This year we will be awarding up to Five - \$1,000 scholarships.

Eligibility Policy

- ▲ The applicant must have a share (savings) account with his/her name as the **Primary Member** at Pyramid Federal Credit Union.
- Selection criteria may include, but are not limited to: GPA, extra-curricular and/or community involvement, career goals, and written skills.
- ▲ Completed applications must be received by mail or at a Pyramid Federal Credit Union office. The deadline to submit is the close of business on Friday, May 2, 2025. Applications MUST be signed by both applicant and parent/guardian.
- Please neatly print or type the application. All other attachments must be typed.
- ▲ All information given on the application must be true.
- ▲ Winner(s) will be selected no later than **Friday, May 9, 2025**. Winners of the scholarship will be notified by mail and email. A copy of the award confirmation will be sent to the winners' school(s). Winners agree that Pyramid Federal Credit Union may feature them on our public website and/or social media.
- ▲ In order to receive the proceeds, the applicant must be a high school senior in good standing and must be enrolled as a full-time student at a four-year or technical college for the Fall 2025 semester. Scholarship payments are awarded at 50% each semester. To receive second-semester payments, students will need to provide proof of successful completion (at least 3.0 GPA) from the first semester and verification of registration for the second semester.
- Pyramid Federal Credit Union reserves the right to withhold the scholarship if it is in the best interest of the scholarship program, or the credit union.
- ▲ Any student questions or circumstances regarding this eligibility policy are to be dealt with at the time of application.
- ▲ Decisions of the Pyramid Federal Credit Union Scholarship committee are final.
